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Read the diagram from top to bottom
 Arrow thickness corresponds to accumulated probability
 Decimal probabilities (e.g 0.8 0.2) are for each node
 Dotted lines denote options that are possible, but with probability too low to calculate

Data on chances of 2 or 3 party coalitions, and chances of Laschet or Scholz leading a coalition, are roughly based on the work of The Economist <https://www.economist.com/graphic-detail/who-will-succeed-angela-merkel> and adapted based on latest polling, correct as close as possible to the date of the diagram. Chances at other nodes based on educated guesswork and statements made by party leaders. Assumption that all 3-party coalitions shown are mathematically possible - chances of this >90%.

Transparency: Jon Worth is a member of the German Grüne, but this diagram is produced based on assessment of what Jon thinks WILL happen, and not based on what he WANTS to happen!
