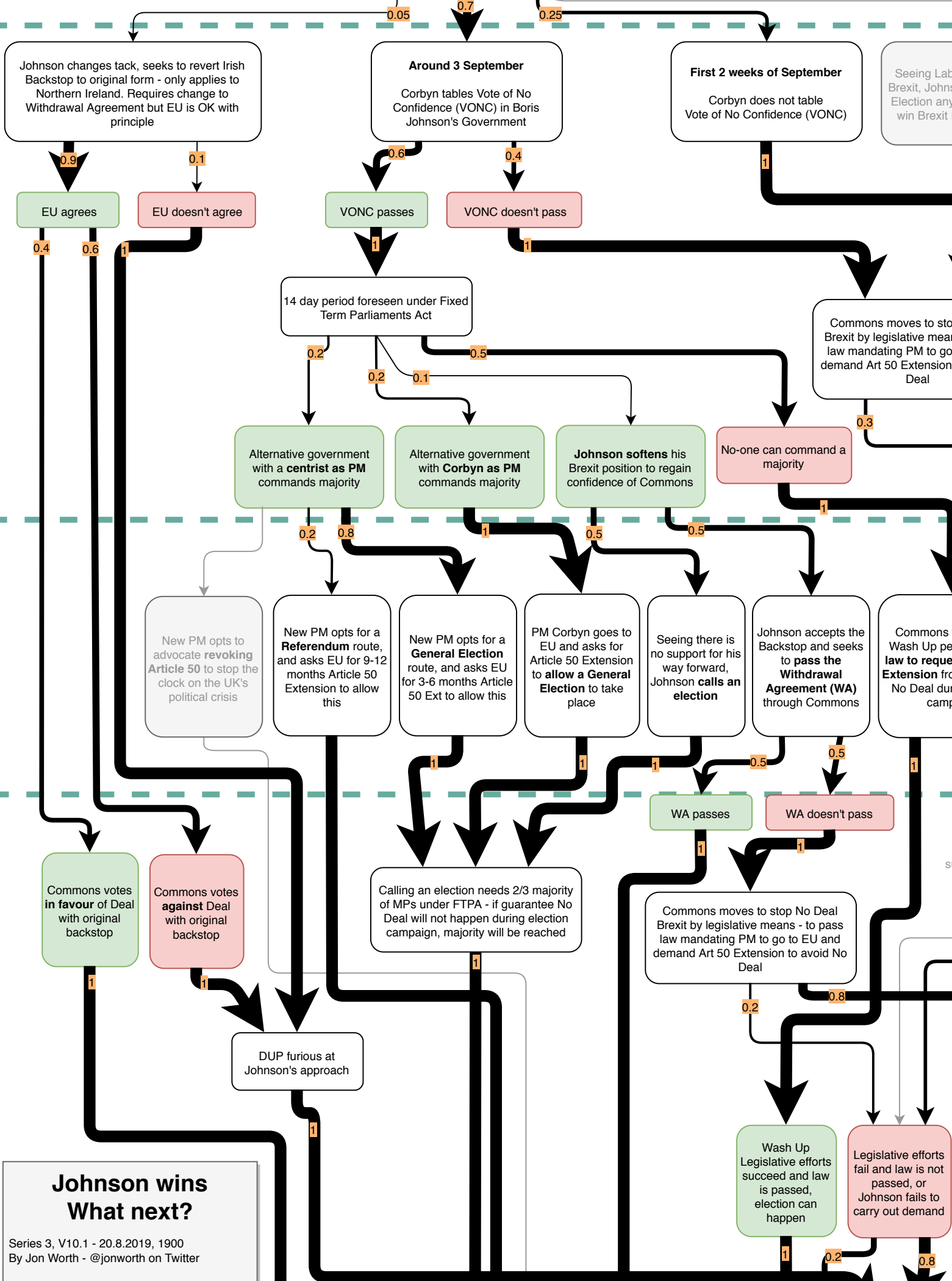

Black line - thin - low probability

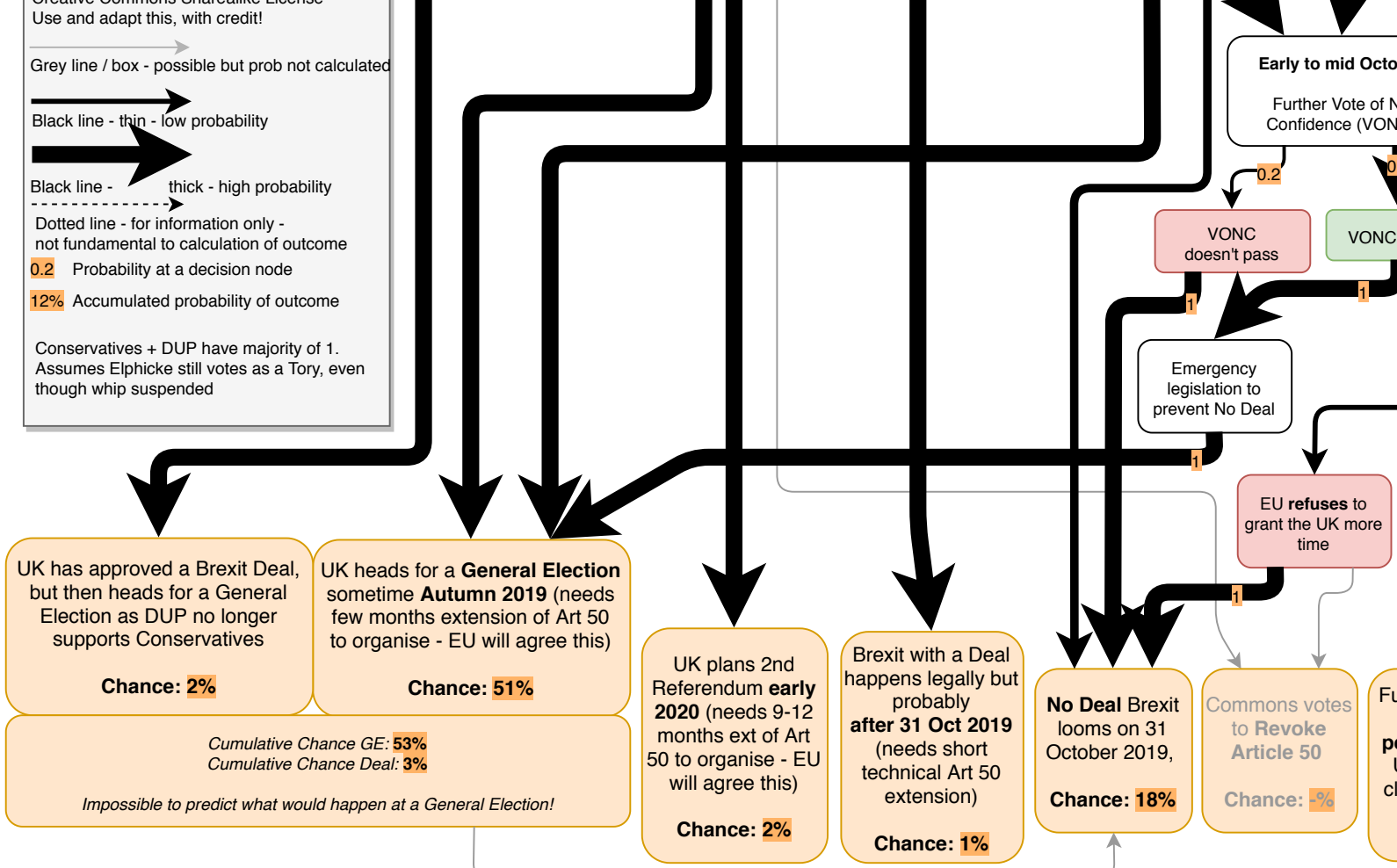
Black line - thick - high probability
