

UK heads for a

Chance: 61%

UK plans 2nd
Referendum, needs
extra time from EU to
do this - referendum
early 2020

Chance: 4%

No Deal Brexit looms on 31 October 2019 -Commons will seek to thwart this

Chance: 19%

Further extension to Article 50 period requested by UK

Chance: 8%

Brexit with a Deal happens legally but possibly after 31 October 2019

Chance: 8%

After Peterborough by-election still little shift in Labour's position - so this assumes Labour's position does not change

Labour could also promise a 2nd Referendum in a General Election manifesto?

A Tory General Election manifesto could demand a No Deal Brexit - and if Remain parties were not to unite this could prevail too complex to add odds for this currently
