

Johnson wins What next?

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Grey line / box - possible but prob not calculated

Black line - thin - low probability

Black line - thick - high probability

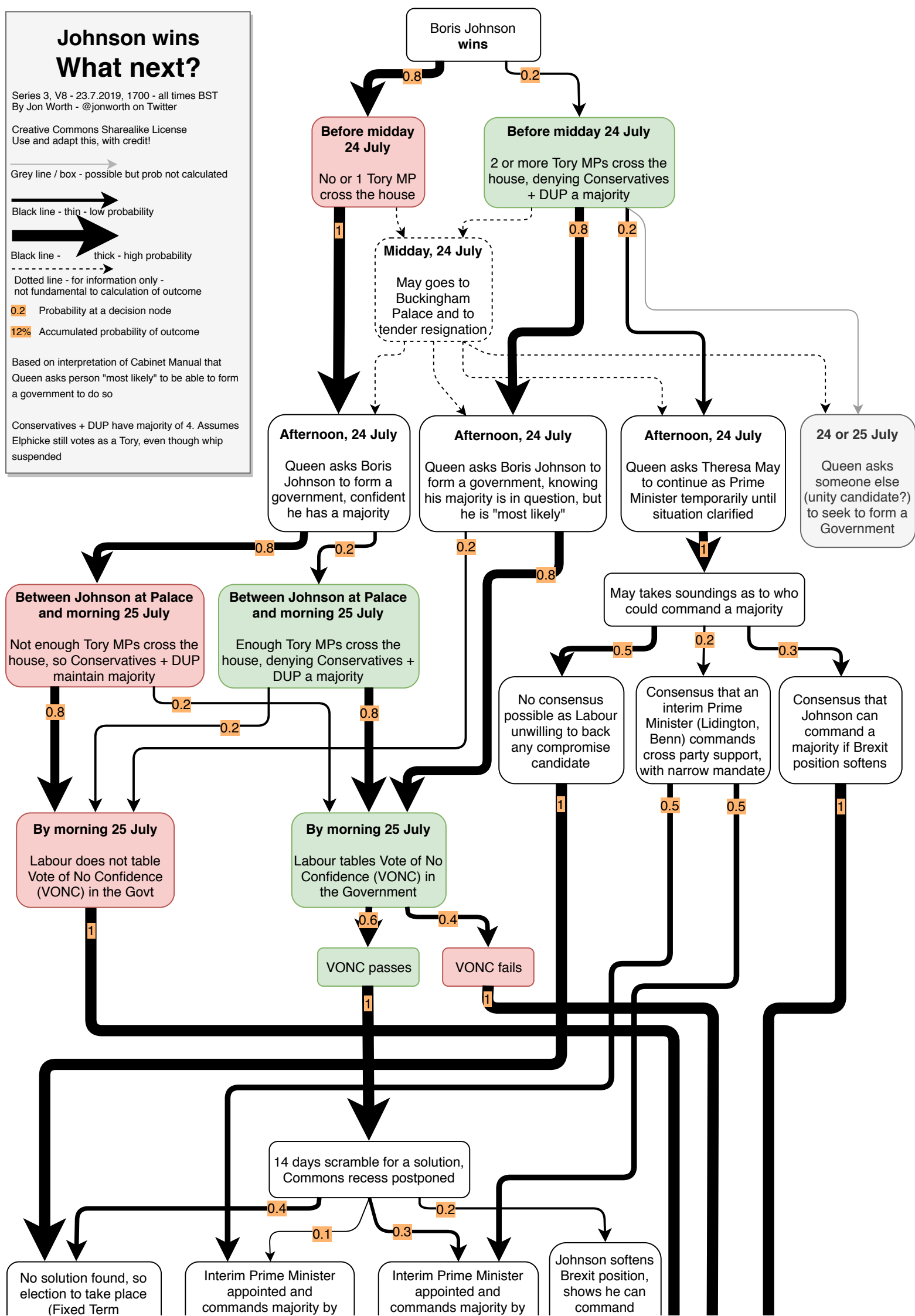
Dotted line - for information only - not fundamental to calculation of outcome

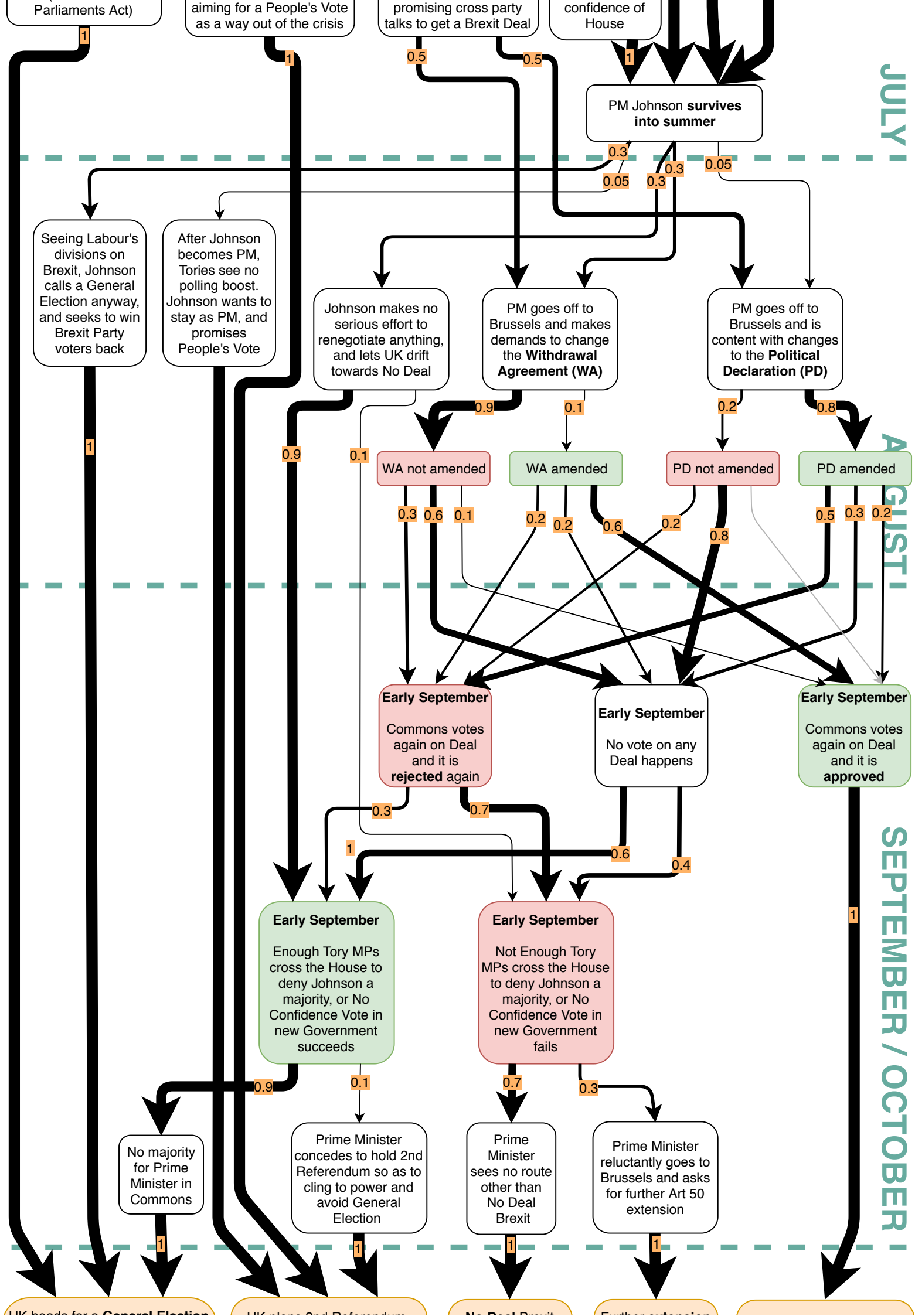
0.2 Probability at a decision node

12% Accumulated probability of outcome

Based on interpretation of Cabinet Manual that Queen asks person "most likely" to be able to form a government to do so

Conservatives + DUP have majority of 4. Assumes Elphicke still votes as a Tory, even though whip suspended





UK heads for a **General Election** sometime before **31 Oct 2019** (might need technical Art 50 extension to organise)

Chance: 67%

Note: currently impossible to predict what would happen at a General Election!

UK plans 2nd Referendum, needs extra time from EU to do this - referendum **early 2020** (certainly needs technical Art 50 extension to organise)

Chance: 10%

No Deal Brexit looms on 31 October 2019 - Commons will seek to thwart this

Chance: 12%

Further **extension to Article 50 period** requested by UK, but with no clear justification

Chance: 5%

Brexit with a Deal happens legally but possibly **after 31 October 2019** (might need technical Art 50 extension)

Chance: 6%
