



These probabilities are repeated here

Assumption that more MPs will back Johnson in public (to appease local party members) than will actually back him in private in the 1922 Committee nomination process

These numbers are based only on the assumption that Johnson is running (or not), not whether he makes it to 100 nominations. Even if Johnson tries and fails that makes it harder for Mordaunt

ERGers switching to Sunak makes task hard for Mordaunt

These are the probability calculations for the next step

Sunak eliminated in MPs vote

Theoretically Johnson could step down here, but I assume his ego is too large, so he will not

Chances online vote causes chaos have been increased, as news that up to 20000 Tory members could be disenfranchised has emerged. Chances this is relevant are higher for Sunak-Mordaunt run off, as that is likely closer than a Johnson-Sunak run off

Sunak steps down, Mordaunt wins by default

Mordaunt steps down, Sunak wins by default
